 - (b) How far was the policy of détente successful between 1972 and the end of 1979? [20]

4 The Modern US, 1980–2008

- (a) Explain why President George W. Bush launched the War on Terror. [10]
- (b) "Reaganomics was successful in solving the problems that faced the US economy during the 1980s." To what extent do you agree with this view? [20]
